

Father, we come with boldness and confidence before the throne of your grace, as we intercede for the nation of Israel. You said you would bless, do good for, and benefit those who bless Israel. Therefore, we bless this nation and its people in the name of Jesus. We pray for the peace of Jerusalem and the entire nation of Israel, including the Jewish diaspora around the world. In accordance with your Word, we say, "O Israel, hope in the Lord! For with the Lord there is mercy and loving-kindness, and with Him there is bountiful redemption."

Father, we discern that there is war in the heavenly realm over Israel right now. We declare that even though Israel is surrounded by its enemies, you, Lord of hosts, strong and mighty in battle, and your armies, stand ready to defend Israel, and prevail over every enemy. Our eyes are opened to see there are more with us than against us.

Lord, we take our place on the front lines, as intercessors. Our hearts are prepared, fully trusting in you. We know you did not give us a spirit of timidity, cowardice, or fear, but instead you gave us a spirit of power, of love, of a calm and well-balanced mind, of discipline, and self-control. We will not be afraid, nor will we allow our hearts to be troubled.

We stand, in the power of your might, clad in your armor, O God, as we wrestle against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this present darkness, and against the spiritual forces of wickedness in supernatural places. We exercise the authority you have given to us, as we tread upon serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy. We boldly declare that nothing will in any way harm us, and we will not be defeated.

We nullify the strategies of the enemy and dissolve and destroy the works of violence and terrorism directed against Israel and the United States of America. We declare that the sound of violence shall no more be heard in Israel, nor in

our own nation-home. We declare that devastation and destruction will not enter through our borders, nor through the borders of Israel. We shall call our walls "salvation", and our gates "praise."

We declare to the nation of Israel, "You shall not be afraid of the terror of the night, nor of the arrow (the evil plots of the enemy) by day, nor of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor of the destruction and sudden death that surprise and lay waste at noon-day. You shall establish yourselves in righteousness, in conformity with God's will and purposes, and you shall be far from even the thought of oppression and destruction, for you shall not fear. You shall not flee from your enemies in terror, for it shall not come near you. When your enemies rise up against you they shall be smitten before your face. They shall come against you in one way and flee from you in seven ways."

Father, we know that your highest purpose is not just for Israel's protection and victory over their natural enemies, but that Israel would confess that Jesus Christ, the Messiah, the Son of God, has come in the flesh, and that there is salvation in Him alone. It is our prayer that the sons of Israel will turn in humility, trembling, and deep repentance to you, Lord, and receive your blessing and goodness in these last days. We decree, Lord, as your voice in the earth, that Israel shall be saved!
