If they are arrested and imprisoned, Lord, remind them of Paul and Silas, who after being beaten, prayed and sang praises in the darkness of the night. Then, you shook the foundations of their prison, till chains were loosed and doors were opened. Do it again, Lord! Show your awesome power to deliver your people!

Father, Jesus commissioned us, as His Body, to go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. Our suffering brothers and sisters are reaching people in their own lands where we cannot currently go. Just as Jesus worked

with the early Church, confirming His Word with the accompanying signs, we are assured that miracles, signs and wonders will abound in these nations as the Word goes forth, bringing glory to you. O God, look on the threats made against your people, and grant that they, with all boldness, may speak your Word, by stretching out your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the mighty name of Jesus!

Father, hear the earnest prayers of your people. When they pray, shake their meeting places, fill them with Holy Spirit power, and help them speak your Word passionately and with fearless confidence. With great power, and with miracles, signs and wonders, may they give witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus! And may your grace be upon them all!
